ORDINANCE NO. 501

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY ESTABLISHING BUILDING PERMIT FEES AND SUPERSEDING TOWN OF HOLLY ORDINANCE NO. 187 (1967), ORDINANCE NO. 221 (1970) AND ORDINANCE NO. 484 (2011)

WHEREAS, the International Code Council, Inc. has issued a 2006 edition of the "International Building Code;" and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado has adopted the 2006 edition of the "International Building Code" for application within corporate limits of the Town of Holly, Colorado and for application to property owned by the Town outside the Town's corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Town of Holly is compelled to charge building permit fees commensurate with fees established by Town of Holly Ordinance No. 187 (1967), Town of Holly Ordinance No. 221 (1970) and Town of Holly Ordinance No. 484 (2011); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado desires to establish Building Permit Fees that reflect the current revenue needs of the building department of the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 edition of the "International Building Code" establishes Sections and Sub-sections that are subject to permit fees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is not desirous of retaining any revenue fee remaining upon completion of building project and inspection and all related costs have been covered; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Town of Holly is compelled to document the issued permits and correlating fees and associated costs to present to the Financial Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Holly Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado that:

Section 1. Fees

A. Residential

- 2. Plan review with Town Administrator \$50.00/Hour
- 3. After all inspections are completed, any amounts of less than \$100.00 shall not be refunded.

C. Refunds

- 1. Any permit refund shall be approved by the Finance Committee of the Board of Trustees.
- 2. The Finance Committee may authorize refunding of not more than eighty percent (80%) of the permit fee when a permit has expired with no work commenced.

D. Penalties

- 1. Any work on a building, structure, electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system before obtaining the necessary permit shall be subject to a penalty of one hundred percent (100%) of the required permit fee.
- 2. Failure of permit holder to contact building inspector for routine inspections of the project shall be subject to a penalty of one hundred percent (100%) of the required permit fee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado that the following sections and subsections pertaining to building permit fees are intended for application within corporate limits of the Town of Holly, Colorado and for application to property owned by the Town outside the Town's corporate limits:

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of the Town in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance, resolution, regulation, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 7. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption.
