A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO AUTHORIZING RATE ADJUSTMENTS TO CERTAIN CLASSIFICATIONS RELATING TO THE WATER AND SEWERAGE FACILITIES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly approved Ordinance No 470; Section 2: which set annual increases to be applied to monthly minimum usage of each meter served by the Town's municipal water system; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly approved Ordinance No. 470; Sections 8, 9, 10 and 11 which pertain to the Town's sewerage utility classifications and annual rate tariff increases for all customers served within and without the corporate limits of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly has reviewed the water and sewer utility reserves during the 2017 budget process and determined a need to advance to the 2017 approved annual increase to the rates detailed in Sections 2, 9, 10 and 11;
