

## RESOLUTION 2020-6

### A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY AUTHORIZING RATE ADJUSTMENTS TO WATER TAPS AND SEWER TAPS, CLASSIFICATIONS OF THE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENT; AND SUPERSEDING ORDINANCE 470

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Holly provides water, sewer and electric service to all residents, therefore, it is in the best interest of the Town to install water and sewer taps to all Town residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Holly must maintain rates for water and sewer taps at a cost that is economically feasible for the Town of Holly and must adjust said rates from time to time in order to comply with Colorado regulation and the 2006 International Plumbing Code; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2010, Ordinance No. 470 approved the following rates under Section 6. Each ¾" water tap will be charged at the rate of \$200. Each additional ¼" increase will be charged at the rate of \$50. Section 10. Each sewer tap will be charged at the rate of \$300; and

**WHEREAS**, the department's rates do not allow a sufficient rate to recover material and labor cost; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town must add Additional Charges to the set water and sewer tap fees. The Additional Charges applicable to water and sewer taps include: labor, equipment and materials; and

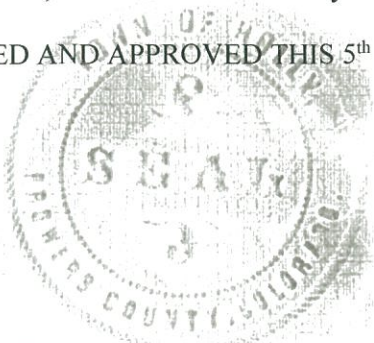
**WHEREAS**, in the case of a new tap request in which the location impairs streets or public thoroughways, all necessary repairs including labor, equipment, and material will be at the customer's expense to bring the public street or thoroughway back to pre-digging condition; and

**WHEREAS**, water and sewer tap fees will be charged at the same rate regardless if the customer's tap request is in town limits or outside of town limits, given such location is within the Town of Holly service area; and

**WHEREAS**, an approximate total that the customers may incur will be considered, in which a deposit may be requested prior to scheduling the tap project.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Holly, Colorado, a municipal corporation, the aforementioned Additional Charges for water and sewer taps: labor, equipment, and materials are hereby adopted and will become effective August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
