

RESOLUTION 2022-2

A RESOLUTION TO CANCEL THE TOWN ELECTION THAT WAS TO BE HELD ON APRIL 5, 2022, AS PROVIDED FOR IN TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 339

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 31-10-507 provides that if a municipality has adopted an ordinance addressing cancellation of elections, it may cancel an election where there are not more candidates than offices to be filled; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for filing nomination petitions was January 24, 2022; seventy-one days before the election date, and there were not more candidates nominated than offices to be filled at the April 5, 2022 election; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for filing affidavits of intent for write-in candidates was January 28, 2022; at the close of the business day prior to the sixty-fourth day before the election date; and

WHEREAS, Town of Holly Ordinance No. 339 provides that the Board of Trustees ("Board") may, by resolution, direct the Town Clerk to cancel a municipal election and declare the candidates elected if the only matter before the voters is the election of persons to office, and if at the close of business on the sixty-fourth day before said municipal election, there is not more than one (1) candidate per seat to be filled at such election, including candidates filing affidavits of intent; and

WHEREAS, the only matter before the voters is the election of candidates to office; and

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 31-10-507, upon such declaration, the candidates shall be deemed elected.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HOLLY, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to cancel the April 5, 2022 regular municipal election for the Town of Holly.

Section 2. The following individuals submitted the appropriate petitions and affidavits to be included on the ballot, which petitions have been found to be in substantial compliance with the Colorado Municipal Election Code; and are hereby declared elected to the respective positions and terms:

One (4) year term for Trustee
One (4) year term for Trustee
One (4) year term for Trustee
One (2) year term for Mayor

Section 3. Notice of cancellation of the election shall be published, if possible, and notice of such cancellation shall be posted at each polling place and in not less than one (1) other public place.
